6. You shall not commit adultery
7. You shall not steal
8. You shall not bear false witness
9. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife
10. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods

### **Abbreviated Protestant Ten Commandments:**

1. You shall have no other gods but me.
2. You shall not make unto you any graven images
3. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain
4. You shall remember the Sabbath and keep it holy
5. Honor your mother and father
6. You shall not murder
7. You shall not commit adultery
8. You shall not steal
9. You shall not bear false witness
10. You shall not covet anything that belongs to your neighbor

### **Jamie's Ten Commandments:**

1. You shall believe in thy self.
2. You shall look upon yourself as a thing of beauty and treat yourself with respect
3. You shall not take yourself for granted
4. You shall remember that everyday is special and should live life to the fullest
5. Honor your mother and father as they honor you
6. You shall not murder
7. You shall not commit adultery
8. You shall not steal
9. You shall not bear false witness
10. You shall not covet anything that belongs to your neighbor
